THE FELLOWSHIP

Aims to promote scientific relationships between early-career scientists and established investigators and to help awardees become more familiar with the areas of emotional wellbeing (EWB), brain aging, and cross-species driven research methods, generate and refine their own proposals for the study of EWB and aging, and develop a network of colleagues with complementary interests.

- Up to \$500 for travel costs
- Up to \$200 per night for 5 nights of lodging
- \$425 (Postdocs) OR \$920 (Professionals) for conference registration
